Odyssey House Louisiana, Inc. is pleased to announce the **Offender Re-entry Program (ORP)**, a comprehensive community reentry program with a focus on intensive case management and substance abuse treatment for men who are currently incarcerated at Louisiana State Angola Penitentiary and completed the LSP Prison Reentry Program and/or are currently incarcerated in a prison within the metropolitan region of New Orleans and will be returning to the New Orleans metropolitan region.

What is Case Management?

Case management is a collaborative process of assessment, planning, facilitation, care coordination, evaluation, and advocacy for options and services to meet your comprehensive health needs through communication and available resources to promote quality outcomes.

OHL has operated case management programs for many years and has past experience in case management for ex-offenders.



The ORP program is funded by a \$1.2 million grant awarded by the Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration for period of three (3) years.

How do I qualify for ORP?

You may qualify for ORP if you:

- Are 18 years or older;
- Are currently incarcerated at Louisiana State Angola Penitentiary and completed the LSP Prison Reentry Program and/or are currently incarcerated in a prison within the metropolitan region of New Orleans;
- Will be returning to the New Orleans metropolitan region post-release; and,
- Have a primary problem of drug or alcohol addiction and/or mental health issue(s).
